## **Technical Specification**

### **Equipment :AED Trainer**

1. Should be a realistic and affordable AED trainer that reflects the operation of a live AED in appearance, operation, and voice prompts
2. The trainer should be 2015 AHA Guidelines compliant
3. Should have at least ten pre-configured sudden cardiac scenarios compatible with training programs developed by internationally recognized responder programs and also should have the capability to upload customized scenarios
4. Should be supplied with remote control for manual scenario selection pause/ resume function, AED trainer with 2 volume control, motions artifact, low battery or replace battery, loose electrodes connection, shockable or non shockable rhythms, and error conditions
5. Should have a realistic battery case that simulates detachment and insertion of the battery pack.
6. Should have a pull-tab status window for maintenance training
7. Should be supplied with soft pack with “1-2-3” protocol card for added training realism and durable storage of the equipment
8. Should be supplied with battery pack and the battery pack shall be covered under warranty.
9. Should have feedback mechanism as per AHA curriculum 2015
